OUTLINE

This course covers the first half of Elementary Japanese, which is equivalent to the 4th level of the Japanese proficiency test. Its emphasis is not only on structure building but on proficiency of the language use.

STUDENT LEVEL

Those who have NO or very limited knowledge of Japanese language.

Those who have taken formal Japanese courses in the past should consult the instructor in charge of placement for the Basic Japanese and Upper Elementary Japanese.

STRUCTURE

1. This course covers grammars and vocabulary equivalent to the 4th level of the Japanese Proficiency Test.

2. The goal of the course is for the students to be able to express themselves in single sentences.

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed by a number of quizzes, a final exam and a final presentation.

You must attend at least two-thirds of the classes in order to take the final exam. Keep in mind that being late or leaving early three times counts as one absence.

1. In one class Kanji equivalent to the 4th level of the Japanese proficiency Test will be learned. The goal is for the students to be able to read and write Kanji in context.
2. In another class by activities using 4 skills, students will practice how to do several things with Japanese language.

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed by a number of quizzes, a final exam.

You must attend at least two-thirds of the classes in order to take the final exam. Keep in mind that being late or leaving early three times counts as one absence.

OUTLINE

This course covers the second half of Elementary Japanese, which is equivalent to the 3rd level of the Japanese proficiency test. Its emphasis is not only on structure building but on proficiency of the language use.

STUDENT LEVEL

1. Those who are placed in Upper Elementary Japanese from the results of their placement test.
2. In principle, students are expected to have mastered the first half of elementary Japanese before signing up for this course. If this is not the case, you are required to discuss the matter with the instructor.

STRUCTURE

1. This course covers grammars and vocabulary and Kanji equivalent to the 3rd level of the Japanese Proficiency Test.
2. The goal of the course is for the students to be able to express about themselves in short discourse.

ASSESSMENT

There will be three exams. Each exam comprises a listening test, written test, and an oral test.

Assessment value for the semester is set as follows.

First exam. 20% Second exam. 40% Final exam 40%
