“SHIRAKAMI-SANCHI” publishes original papers, reports, and review articles dealing with all aspects of nature and human activities in Shirakami-Sanchi and related subjects.

[Copyright]

Authors must complete our copyright transfer form, when submitting the manuscript. Copyrights for the paper (including text, tables and figures) published in “SHIRAKAMI-SANCHI” will be owned by the Shirakami Institute for Environmental Sciences, Hirosaki University. However, the authors retain the right to reproduce or release online the whole or a part of the paper personally (not for commercial purpose).

[Preparation and contents of manuscripts]

Manuscripts must be written in English, and must not have been published nor submitted for publication elsewhere. Authors must submit manuscripts either by a USB memory, a CD-R, or an e-mail, together with 3 sets of printed copies. Microsoft Word format (.doc or .docx) is recommended.

A paper should be organized in the following order as far as possible. 1. Title and its abbreviated running title no more than 40 letters. 2. Name of author, postal address, and e-mail address, for each author. 3. Abstracts. 4. Keywords (five words not in the title, for the purpose of indexing). 5. Introduction. 6. Materials and Methods. 7. Results. 8. Discussion. 9. Conclusions. 10. Acknowledgements. 11. References. 12. Appendices. Depending on the nature of the paper, conclusions, acknowledgements, and appendices may be omitted, if not necessary.

[Citations of literatures]

In the text, citations should be indicated as follow ... (Alexander 1957a, b, 1981; Kawase and Saigusa 1984; Pape *et al.* 2006)...., ... according to Alexander (1957a, b, 1981), Kawase and Saigusa (1984), Pape *et al.* (2006). For citation of website in the text, indicate the title of the site and the date the information was obtained. Examples ...(website Dhalma Crane-Fly Heaven, April 2, 2010)...., ... according to a website Dhalma Crane-Fly Heaven (April 2, 2010)...

All references cited in the text should be listed alphabetically at the end of the paper (before appendix). Names of all authors should be given here. Websites cited should be listed with URL at the end. Examples below.

All tables and figures must be numbered and saved separately. Figures should be saved in appropriate sizes (>350dpi) in JPG or TIFF format. Sufficient explanations for understanding tables and figures without referring the text are required.
